

How To Play Craps

Objective of the Game

The objective in craps is to predict the outcome of the roll or series of rolls of two six-sided dice. Bets can be placed on various outcomes, with the most popular being the Pass Line and Dont Pass bets.

Basic Gameplay

The game begins with the come-out roll:

- If the shooter rolls a 7 or 11, Pass Line bets win.
- If the shooter rolls a 2, 3, or 12, Pass Line bets lose.
- Any other number (4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10) becomes the point.

Point Phase

Once a point is established, the shooter keeps rolling:

- If the point is rolled again before a 7, Pass Line bets win.
- If a 7 is rolled before the point, Pass Line bets lose (this is called sevening out).

Popular Bets

- ****Pass Line****: Basic bet on the shooter winning.
- ****Dont Pass Line****: Bet against the shooter.
- ****Come Bet****: Similar to Pass Line, but placed after the come-out roll.
- ****Dont Come Bet****: Similar to Dont Pass Line, but after the come-out roll.
- ****Odds Bet****: An additional bet backing up your Pass/Dont Pass or Come/Dont Come bet.

Craps Tips

- Stick to low house edge bets like Pass Line and Come.
- Avoid high-risk bets like the Big 6/8 or Hardways.
- Practice makes perfectget comfortable with the table layout.

How To Play Craps

- Dont be intimidated by the fast pace. Take your time.
